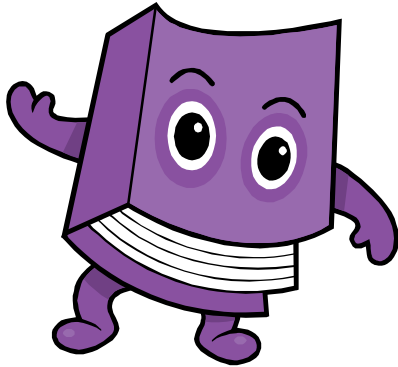

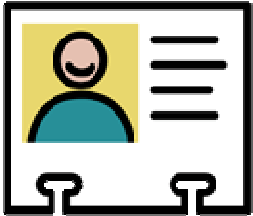
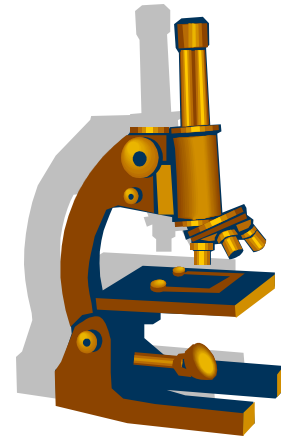


SCIENCE FAIR
